Oct. 24th: Nominating Petitions Due

A Nominating Petition is posted on LACAA.org. Wet or electronic signatures are acceptable. The Petition must be filed with Board Treasurer Jessica Howell at jessicalacaa@gmail.com no later than **5:00 p.m., Friday, Oct. 24th.**

Candidates for President, 2nd Vice President and Secretary must file a petition signed by at least **fifteen (15)** LACAA members in good standing. Candidates for Civil Director and Criminal Director must file a petition signed by at least **ten (10)** LACAA members in good standing *assigned to those respective branches*. Candidates for Proprietary Director must file a petition signed by at least **five (5)** LACAA members in good standing *assigned to one of the Proprietary branches*.

Candidate “campaign statement” (not to exceed 300 words)

Candidates may provide a campaign statement to be provided to voting members with their ballot. The campaign statement must have, at the top of the page:

“Campaign statement of (insert name of candidate)
Candidate for (insert name of position sought)”

The campaign statement must be filed with Board Treasurer Jessica Howell at jessicalacaa@gmail.com no later than on **5:00 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 24th.** All statements must be in Word format.
